2	Court of the State of California, in and for the County of San Francisco, the Honorable Charlotte W.
3	Woolard presiding. Cotkin & Collins, Joan M. Cotkin appeared as attorneys for plaintiff Transport
4	Insurance Company; Sidley Austin LLP, William Sneed, and Leo Spooner appeared as attorneys
