A BILL

To provide that the reinsurance fee for the transitional reinsurance program under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act be applied equally to all health insurance issuers and group health plans.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Union Tax Fairness
5 Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF REINSURANCE FEE.**

2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the pay-
3 ments required to be made by health insurance issuers and
4 third party administrators (on behalf of group health
5 plans) under section 1341(b)(1)(A) of the Patient Protec-
6 tion and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18061(b)(1)(A))
7 shall be applied equally to all such issuers and administra-
8 tors and may not be waived on behalf of any such issuer,
9 administrator or group health plan.
